Vinification/elevage: Alcoholic fermentation and ageing in 2 individual oak barrels for 18 months- 50% new oak and 50% of 1 vintage from the Centre region of France.

Tasting notes: Crystalline Pale gold in colour with hints of fresh rose petal. Elegant and approachable, this wine is typical for the vintage in its subtlety and purity.
