Origin: Puligny Montrachet “les Folatières”

Vinification/elevage: Alcoholic fermentation and ageing for 18 months in 1 new oak barrel- from the Centre region of France.

Tasting notes: Pale gold in colour with refined aromas of subtle white flowers and *pivoine*. Although very approachable and accessible to all palettes with fresh fleshy fruit and a purity typical of 2008 white wines, it has an underlying aromatic nuance which will delight even the most sophisticated of palettes! Incredible balance with great length and persistence. Drink now or hold. 2010-2020.
